15 Dog Boarding Kennels in Los Angeles

Are you a dog owner who lives in LA?

Are you planning a trip and are unsure of where to leave your dog while you're way?

Continue reading to learn about 15 dog boarding kennels in Los Angeles.

1. Wagville

Wagville is a **boarding facility** for your dog with a holistic view, where your pup can receive special services offered to make your pup's "vacation" extra special. The highly trained and certified staff at Wagville strive to provide a complete understanding of your dog's needs, and to provide for all aspects of your dog's well-being including nutrition, exercise, social interaction, play, and overall health. While your dog is boarded at the facility, your pup will enjoy social interaction in the doggie daycare during daytime hours. There is indoor and outdoor space provided, and comfortable sleeping doggie beds. Staff is on site 24 hours per day.

Standard rates for a 24-hour period are \$50, however, several options, including private sleeping arrangements, or sleeping with a caregiver are also available for an additional cost.

Other services that can be obtained for an additional fee include a doggie shuttle bus, grooming, massage, training, and supplies from the on-site natural pet supply store.

Prior Requirements: Wagville's canine clients must spend a day in the daycare facility before overnight stays to adjust to the setting and minimize stress. A current flea program and medication is required. All dogs over 6 months of age should be spayed or neutered and owners need to provide documentation for up to date DDHLP, Bordetella and Rabies vaccinations.

2. Dogwood Daycare and Boarding

Located at 8652 Venice Boulevard, Los Angeles, between Robertson and La Cienega Boulevards, Dogwood Daycare and Boarding provides a peaceful, clean, safe boarding facility for your dog with 24 hour, on site staff, and security surveillance. They provide 12000 square feet of Indoor and outdoor


space. The facility is cage free. Fees for cage free overnight boarding are \$55 per 24-hour period. There is a limit of 25 dogs being kept overnight at any one time so that individual attention and a comfortable environment can be provided for your dog. Pet owners should bring their own food and treats so that there is minimal disruption to your dog's regular routine. Your pet's personal bedding and toys are also recommended. Baths are available for an additional fee.

Prior Requirements: Dogwood Daycare and Boarding does not accept all breeds of dogs due to insurance restrictions. Boxers, Dobermans, German Shepherds, Mastiffs, Pit Bulls and Rottweilers, or any dog that is deemed to show aggressive tendencies cannot be accepted. Dogs staying at the facility must be older than 4 months of age, and spayed or neutered, if 6 months of age or older. Current flea treatment is required as well as proof of Bordetella, DHPP and Rabies vaccination.

3. South Park Doggie Downtown LA Daycare and Boarding

This [Los Angeles](#) boarding facility is centrally and conveniently located downtown at 1320 South Ground Avenue, Los Angeles. The indoor facility has soft rubber mats for indoor play and exercise, and boarded dogs are treated to at least two outdoor walks per day in a small group with compatible dogs. During your furry friends stay, your dog will enjoy play with other well socialized dogs in the daycare area, and overnight accommodations on elevated doggie beds. Private rooms for overnight stays are also available for an additional fee. There is 24 hour trained staff on site to provide supervision, and after hours pick up is available. Additional training services and grooming are available on request at additional expense. You have the option to provide your own food, or purchase high quality food on site. Security and fire systems are in place, and webcams are available to keep tabs on your Fido's daily fun.

Prior requirements: All dogs are required to undergo a socialization assessment and owners will need to complete a questionnaire prior to their stay. Canine visitors must be currently vaccinated for Rabies, DHLPP and Bordetella. Dogs must also be spayed or neutered.

Prices for overnight boarding vary depending on length of stay and the size of dog but range from \$30 for a small dog on a multi night stay to \$60 for large dogs on a short-term stay. Private accommodations for overnight stays are available at additional cost.

4. Glen's Dog Inn

For dogs who enjoy the outdoors, and a little scenery, check out Glen's Dog Inn which is conveniently located off the 405 just minutes from LAX. This boarding facilities has been in business for over 12 years with dedicated and experienced staff. The property is tree shaded with well fenced, secure play yards where dogs can play individually or in small groups. Dogs are allowed to choose whether they want to socialize or have some alone time. Ground cover is pebbled which is easier on your pup's paws and joints. Dogs have indoor sleeping facilities that are well ventilated. Owners can bring their own food or choose the special diet provided, which consists of tuna and kibble, to prevent intestinal distress in visiting pooches. Pick up, drop off, and visitation is by appointment only. Prices are \$35 per day with discounts for multiple dogs.

Prior Requirements: Male dogs must be neutered, vaccinations must be current, and some dog breeds are not accepted. Contact for more details.

5. Dog Resort North Hollywood

This highly rated doggie hotel offers 16000 square feet of indoor space for your visiting pup, with professionally trained staff on site 24/7. All breeds are welcome at this temperature controlled facility, with non-slip flooring for safe play. A variety of rooms and service levels are available. All visiting pups have private room accommodations. There are standard rooms and a variety of suites where multiple dogs from the same household can enjoy the company of their mates, or where individual dogs can just enjoy a little more space and luxury. Varying service levels and pricing are available for different

6. Kennel Club LAX

Founded in 1983, the female owned Kennel Club LAX has been recognized in numerous articles and organizations for its services. There is trained staff on site 24 hours a day, many of which are long term employees of 10 to 20 years. The property offers a state of the art program with ventilation, security, and surveillance systems, 12000 square feet of indoor space, 12,000 square feet of outdoor play yards, and even a doggie swimming pool. Tours of the facility are available. Additional transportation, grooming, and training services are available.

7. The Wags Club

Overnight boarding, daycare, training, and grooming services are provided. The Wags Club prides itself on providing an enjoyable, relaxing, and luxurious vacation spot for your pup. Dogs are monitored 24 hours a day, and updates and photos are posted online for owners to access.

8. Go Dog LA

This award winning, cage free kennel, allows dogs to socialize, play, and sleep together in a safe environment, where dogs are supervised 24 hours a day. Small and large dogs are kept separate for safety. The facility has 9000 square feet of indoor and outdoor space with rubber flooring for non-slip play in the indoor areas and outdoor spaces with shade, trees, pools, and play equipment. The base rate for overnight stays is \$49 per night with discounts and addons are available.

Prior requirements: Current vaccinations including Bordetella are required and dogs must be spayed or neutered if more than 6 months of age. A flea/tic check will be performed prior to admittance, and all dogs should be on an active anti-flea program. Prescreening needs to be completed to ensure your pup will fit into the cage free environment. You can complete agreement forms at

9. Camp Best Friends

At Camp Best Friends (C.B.F.) dogs enjoy their own separate spaces with individualized pet care to accommodate both large and small breeds. All dogs have a private run and personal care. Exercise in a larger area is provided twice a day, with approximately 4 walks per day by staff. Staff area available on site around the clock and will accommodate special needs and requests. C.B.F. has celebrated their 25th anniversary and welcomes tours of their facility. C.B.F. is located near the 405 and 10 freeways at 1819 Pontius Avenue in Los Angeles.

Prior Requirements: Vaccinations must be up to date.

10. West LA Dogs

This 14000-square foot facility has indoor and outdoor play space and is located centrally in West Los Angeles near the 405 and 10 freeways. West LA Dogs staff are offered training at the Cesar Milan Dog Psychology Centre and can provide knowledgeable personal care to your furry friend. Separate areas are provided for large and small dogs, and access to indoor space is always accessible. The standard fee is \$45 per night for cage free or kennel accommodations. Private rooms and multi dog discounts are available at different rates.

Prior Requirements: Dogs must be vaccinated, and neutered or spayed. Unaltered dogs can be accommodated but for an extra charge. Dogs will be checked for fleas, if fleas are found, you will be notified, and your dog given flea treatment for an additional fee. Dogs must also pass a 3-hour temperament test in order to mingle with other canine companions. There is a \$5 fee for this assessment.

11. Chateau Marmutt

Established in 1999, your furry friend will enjoy a stay at Chateau Marmutt, located near West Hollywood, Beverley Hills, and the Sunset Strip. Trained staff is on site and vigilant 24 hours a day, and dogs are grouped according to size and temperament, so small dogs can feel safe and larger dogs can really romp!

The standard overnight stay fee is \$60 per night. Other services available for your canine companion include a shuttle service, grooming, and a pet boutique on site.

The first K9 location opened in 2006, and the Los Angeles location opened in 2011. The kennel is owned and operated by a professional dog trainer, and offers many services to vacationing pups. Standard and luxury suites are available depending on your pooches needs. All visiting canines receive 4-6 potty breaks a day, and owners are encouraged to select additional services such as playtime, walks, swimming, grooming or massage for an additional charge. Prior Requirements: All vising dogs must be current on vaccinations, current on flea treatment, in good health, and should be altered, or have a breeders certificate or special exemption.

13. Sandlot K9

This metro LA training and boarding service is a great spot for your pup to vacation with many daily activities available including basic and advanced training, grooming and playtime. The philosophy of Sandlot K9 is that socialization and activity are key to a dog's well-being. Activity, play, and grooming are provided to make sure your canine companion is occupied in body and mind, and content during his or her stay. Activities provided at the Sandlot K9 are designed to help your dog adjust, reduce stress, and improve health. Small dogs and puppies are kept in a separate group from larger more boisterous dogs to ensure safety. It is located at 2202 S Figuero Street, Los Angeles.
